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**PARVEEN KAUR AND ANOTHER VS STATE OF PUNJAB AND
OTHERS**

By order dated 05.11.2019, this Court disposed of Civil Writ
Petition No.32111 of 2019 filed by Parveen Kaur and Sandeep Singh,
who claimed to have gotten married to each other. The Senior
Superintendent of Police, Mansa, District Mansa, Punjab, was thereby
directed to take appropriate action upon their representation for
protection of their lives and liberty in accordance with law. This Court
also made it clear that the said order should not be treated as a stamp of
approval or validity of the alleged marriage between the parties and
that the order would have no impact in the event any challenge was
made to the validity thereof.

While so, RA-CWP-468 of 2019 was filed by the fourth
respondent in the writ petition, the father of Parveen Kaur, seeking
review of the aforestated order. It is his case that the writ petition was
filed projecting Parveen Kaur, the first petitioner therein, as a major but
the fact is that she is still a minor.

Be it noted that the first petitioner filed an affidavit in the

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writ petition stating to the effect that she was a major and that her date of birth is 15.01.2001. However, the Matriculation (Class X) Examination Certificate issued by the Punjab School Education Board to the first petitioner, Parveen Kaur, demonstrates that her date of birth is 27.06.2002.

In that view of the matter, it is clear that the order dated 05.11.2019 was secured from this Court under false pretenses. The review application is accordingly allowed recalling the order dated 05.11.2019 and dismissing Civil Writ Petition No.32111 of 2019. It is left open to the police authorities to take appropriate action in the matter in accordance with law.

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Civil Miscellaneous Application is ordered and the Annexures R-4/1 to R-4/3 are taken on record.
