By this petition, quashing of FIR No. 129, dated 24.08.2018, registered at Police Station Chhajli, District Sangrur, alleging therein the commission of offences punishable under Sections 279/337/338/304-A/427 IPC, is sought, with learned counsel for the petitioner submitting that the affidavit of respondent no. 2, to the effect that the accident in question was not caused due to the negligence of the petitioner, be looked at “sympathetically” by the trial Court.

He further submits that the complainant in the FIR be also summoned.

No comment need be made on the lack of reasoning of the first contention; and as regards the 2nd contention, naturally, in the normal course, the complainant would be a prosecution witness, though whether he chooses to appear or not, and what action thereafter the trial Court takes to secure his presence or otherwise, cannot be commented upon by this Court at this stage, with the trial to still begin.

Consequently, making no comment whatsoever on the merits of the case, for or against the petitioner, this petition is disposed of, with the trial Court

naturally to proceed with the trial on the basis of the evidence led before it by both sides.
