This is a petition filed for grant of bail in case FIR No. 347, dated 13.11.2018, registered under Section 392 IPC at Police Station Narnaund, District Hisar.

The complaint was lodged by Gaurav alleging that he is working in Kaushik Trading Company alongwith his maternal uncle. On 10.11.2018, when he closed his shop and was going to his house with cash, on the way, he was assaulted and amount of Rs. 145000 – 150000 and one mobile phone were snatched. He suspected the role of Mula, Chota Ajay and 3 other persons.

The learned counsel for petitioner has contended that petitioner was not named in FIR. His name has figured in the disclosure statement of Arun alias Mula. All other accused including those who were specifically named in FIR have already been granted bail. The petitioner is in custody since 7.2.2019.

The learned State counsel on instructions from SI Devi Lal states that investigation in case is complete and challan has been presented.

The petitioner is in custody since 7.2.2019. The trial of the case may take long time. No useful purpose will be served by keeping him in custody till the final disposal of the case.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of present case;
without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this criminal
miscellaneous petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be
released on bail subject to his furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to the
satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.

However, if petitioner indulges in any activity of similar nature,
while on bail, prosecution agency will be at liberty to seek cancellation of
order granting bail to petitioner.
