This order shall dispose of the present petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.90 dated 27.09.2015 (Annexure P-1) under Sections 382, 341, 379-B, 411 & 120-B of Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Ajitwal, District Moga.

The petitioner was declared proclaimed offender on 17.04.2017 and is in custody since 11.05.2018. Allegations against the petitioner are of snatching a tractor-trolley. Since the conclusion of the trial will take time, there is no ground for further detention of the petitioner. Accordingly, the present petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing personal bonds in the sum of Rs. one lac with one surety of the like amount to the satisfaction of the trial

Court, subject to the following conditions:-

- (1) Petitioner shall surrender his passport before the trial Court, if any, and shall not leave the country without prior intimation to the Court;
- (2) Petitioner shall not directly or indirectly give any inducement or threat or promise to any witness and
- (3) Petitioner shall attend the Court on each and every date of hearing before the trial Court and in case of his absence, trial Court shall be competent to cancel his bail.

Accordingly, the petition stands allowed.
