Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the respondent-State of Haryana has issued instructions on 27.05.2019 (Annexure P-2) by which, the State of Haryana decided to revise pension/family pension, on the basis of notional pay of the pre-2016 govt. employees, drawing pay in the ACP scale/Pay band+grade pay, at the time of retirement/death, be revised, w.e.f. 01.01.2016 in the ACP table/structure as prescribed by State Government from time to time.

Learned counsel for the petitioners argues that though the period of about six months have elapsed after the issuance of the notification dated 27.05.2019 (Annexure P-2), but the benefit of the same has not been extended to the petitioners.

The prayer of the petitioners is for issuance of a direction to respondent No.2 to grant the petitioners the benefit for which they have become entitled in view of the instructions dated 27.05.2019 (Annexure P-2).

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that for the relief which has been claimed in the present writ petition, the petitioners have

served the respondents with a legal notice dated 09.09.2019 (Annexure P-5) which is still pending consideration with the respondents and the petitioners will be satisfied, at this stage, in case a time bound direction is issued to respondent No.2 to decide the said legal notice by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case or about the entitlement of the petitioners for the relief which has been claimed by them in the legal notice dated 09.09.2019 (Annexure P-5), the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to decide the legal notice dated 09.09.2019 (Annexure P-5), within a period of three months from the receipt of certified copy of this order.
