Petitioner Sonia @ Noni has filed this petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.97 dated 07.08.2017, registered at Police Station Islamabad, Amritsar, District Amritsar, under Sections 302, 450, 454, 380, 411 and 34 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860.

Notice of motion was issued.

Learned State counsel appeared and contested the instant petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and gone through the record.

This is a double murder case. The allegation against the present petitioner is that she along with her husband had gone to the house of brother of the complainant, namely, Subash Chander Arora with the purpose of theft and committed his and his wife's murder.

As per learned State counsel, silver ornaments were recovered

from the present petitioner. On the basis of last seen evidence, she has been nominated as an accused in this case.

Keeping in view the serious allegations; nature and gravity of the offence, I do not find it a fit case where the petitioner is entitled to the benefit of regular bail.

Therefore, finding no merit in the present petition, the same is dismissed.
