The present proceedings have been taken on informatory application dated 15.11.2019 received from the petitioner-Naib Singh by post which has been treated as Habeas Corpus petition.

In the application petitioner-Naib Singh has submitted that the police of Village Mudki, District Ferozepur had kidnapped his son Ninderpal Singh and one Daler Singh from their houses and will implicate them in false case.

Vide order dated 20.11.2019, notice was issued by this Court and Superintendent of Police, Ferozepur was also directed to look into the matter and submit his report.

Reply by way of affidavit dated 20.11.2019 of Satnam Singh, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, SD Rural, District Ferozepur has been received through email.

In the said reply/affidavit it has been mentioned that on the basis of secret information and pursuant to registration of FIR No.117 dated 15.11.2019 under Section 22 of the Narcotic Drugs and

Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 at Police Station Ghallkhurd, Ninderpal Singh @ Ninda and Gurpreet Singh @ Vicky were arrested on 16.11.2019 and 10 gm narcotic powder was recovered from the possession of Ninderpal Singh @ Ninda and 12 gm narcotic powder was recovered from the possession of Gurpreet Singh @ Vicky. On the next day, they were produced before the Judicial Magistrate Ist Class. It has also been mentioned in the said reply/affidavit that Daler Singh was neither arrested nor detained by the police on 15.11.2019.

Since the alleged detainee-Ninderpal Singh @ Ninda was arrested and detained on registration of criminal case against him and has not been illegally detained, no further action is required to be taken on the present petition which is disposed of accordingly.
