The present contempt petition has been filed pleading wilful disobedience of the order dated 14.08.2018 passed in CWP No. 17788 of 2018.

The operational part of the order is quoted below:-

“ At this stage, present petition is disposed of by giving direction to the respondents to look into the legal notices dated 04.05.2018 and 24.05.2018 (Annexures P-2 & P-3) and pass appropriate speaking order(s) in accordance with law within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.”

Reply was filed and copy has already been handed over to the counsel for the petitioners.

Learned State counsel submits that the order of this Court has been complied with and the order in respect of each petitioner has been passed and copies of the same would be supplied to the petitioners within one week from today.

In view of reply, as well as statement made above, learned counsel for the petitioners states that no cause of action survives in the present contempt petition.

Disposed of as infructuous.

Rule issued against the respondents stand discharged.

Petitioners would be at liberty to avail remedy in accordance with law in case they have any grievance with regard to the order passed by respondents.
