The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.276 dated 04.10.2017 under Sections 307, 452, 326, 506, 148, 149 IPC (Sections 302, 201 IPC added later on) registered at Police Station Division Daba, District Ludhiana.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that no overt act has been attributed to the petitioner who was empty handed. The petitioner is in custody for over one year and ten months since his arrest on 30.10.2017.

Learned State counsel states that although challan has been presented but no prosecution witness has been examined.

Heard.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner especially when the petitioner was empty handed, no overt has been attributed to him, he is in custody for over one year and ten months and

conclusion of the trial is likely to take some time, I deem it a fit case to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
