The petitioner filed a writ petition raising a grievance that he retired on 28.2.2018 but his GPF and leave encashment was released only in September 2018 and further that gratuity amount of Rs. 7,70,176/- was still due.

The writ petition was disposed of on 8.4.2019 directing the respondents to decide the legal notice dated 15.3.2019 by passing a speaking order within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order. Further directions was to release monetary benefit, if found due, within a period of next three months.

The present contempt petition is filed pleading that needful has not been done by the respondents.

Learned State counsel on instruction from Mr. Parvesh K. Sood, Office Assistant, Department of Water Supply and Sanitation, Punjab, submits that the entire retiral benefits due as per respondent have been credited to the account of the petitioner. He submits that the decision on the

representation would be taken within four weeks from today and in case any

amount is still found due, the same shall be released within two weeks thereafter.

In view of above, the contempt petition is disposed of.

However, the petitioner if aggrieved of the order shall be at liberty to avail remedy in accordance with law.
