ANIL KSHETARPAL, J.

Petitioner prays for bail pending trial in a criminal case arising out of FIR No.44 dated 28.06.2019 registered under Section 379-B and 411 of the Indian Penal Code at Police Station, Bilga, District Jalandhar.

In nutshell, the case of the prosecution is that two unidentified young persons hit the complainant with *datar*, snatched his mobile phone and wallet containing Rs.3,000/-.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that there is no evidence to connect the petitioner. The petitioner is in custody since 30.06.2019.

Learned counsel for the State submits that two accused, who were apprehended, have nominated the petitioner with disclosure that the petitioner had helped the aforesaid two accused in carrying out the offence.

Investigations are complete and final police report has already been submitted. The petitioner is not involved in any other case.

Without commenting on the merits of the case and keeping in view the aforesaid facts as also conclusion of the trial is likely to take time, it is considered appropriate to release the petitioner on regular bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the concerned trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
