Petitioner is seeking direction to the respondents to call him for interview for the post of PGT Commerce under General category.

On 21.12.2018, this Court passed the following order:-

“The petitioner is participating for the post of PGT Commerce in the general category. The last candidate called for interview has secured 92 marks whereas the petitioner has secured 100 marks. At the time of scrutiny of documents, an objection was raised regarding his STET certificate of 2010.

*Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that as per the judgment passed by this Court in **CWP-2129-2017 Rakesh Kumar and another V/s. State of Haryana and others** (Annexure P-7) the validity of STET shall be considered till 2019.*

Notice of motion for 28.02.2019.

In the meantime, the petitioner will be interviewed

provisionally and his result be kept in sealed cover.”

Learned State counsel has produced the result of the petitioner in a sealed cover, which has been opened by the Reader of this Court. As per result, the petitioner has secured 92 marks in written examination and 12 marks in viva voice (total 104 marks) and the last candidate has secured 116 marks under general category.

In view of the above factual position, the writ petition stands dismissed, as the petitioner has secured less marks than the last candidate.

The result has been returned back in original to learned State counsel in the Court today.
