By way of instant petition, the petitioner is seeking regularization of service along with all consequential benefits at parity with those who have been granted benefit of regularization against sanctioned posts in view of the Punjab Regularization of Service Act, 2018 (Annexure P-3). The petitioner also caused issuance of a Legal Notice dated 16.07.2019 (Annexure P-4), but the same has not been adverted to till date by the respondents. Hence the writ petition.

2. Notice of motion.

3. On advance service of copy of petition, Mr. Mehardeep Singh, Assistant Advocate General, Punjab has put in appearance on behalf of the respondent-State.

4. Given the nature of order being passed, there is no necessity to seek return by any of the respondents as no further proceedings and/or pleadings are required.

5. Without commenting on the merits of the case, the writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to objectively consider the Legal Notice dated 16.07.2019 (Annexure P-4) and also by keeping in view the contentions stated in the present writ petition by treating it as a supplementary representation and pass a speaking order, in accordance with law.

6. Let the needful be done within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

7. Disposed of in above terms.
