The petitioner seeks grant of regular bail in case FIR No. 722 dated 10.08.2019 under Sections 148, 149, 323, 324, 307, 506, 34 IPC registered at Police Station City, District Karnal.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has been in custody for more than three months and that only simple injuries are attributed to him. There is no other criminal case pending against him and, thus, he may be granted regular bail.

Custody certificate dated 26.11.2019 prepared by Sh. Sanjay Bangar, DSP-2, Deputy Superintendent, District Prison, Karnal, has been filed in the Court today and the same is taken on record. According to the certificate, the petitioner has undergone actual custody of three months and thirteen days

Learned State counsel submits that although in the FIR the petitioner has been attributed grievous injuries, in the supplementary statement recorded by the complainant, only simple injuries have been attributed.

In view of the above and the fact that the trial is still at the initial stage as even charges have not yet been framed, the petition is allowed and the petitioner

is directed to be released on regular bail on his furnishing bail and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court concerned.
