Though learned counsel for the petitioner also contests on the merits of the case, to the extent that the investigating officer and the arresting officer was the same, he submits that in any case the quantity of contraband recovered from the petitioner, even as per the case of the investigating agency, is well below commercial quantity, it being a total of 75 grams, with the commercial quantity being above 250 grams.

Keeping that in view, with it also seen that no other criminal case is shown to be registered against the petitioner, with him having been in custody for more than three and a half months, the petition is allowed. The petitioner shall be admitted to bail upon his furnishing adequate bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the learned trial Court.
