This writ petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India has been filed for the issuance of a writ, in the nature of mandamus directing the respondent to pay the adequate compensation to the petitioner as per judgment dated 15.9.2017 (Annexure P-5) of Hon'ble the Supreme Court of India passed in Writ Petition (Civil) No.406 of 2013.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that at this stage, he would be satisfied, if a direction is issued to respondent No.1-Principal Secretary, Department of Home Affairs and Justice, Punjab, Punjab Civil Secretariat, Chandigarh to consider and decide the representation dated 22.9.2016 (Annexure P-2) expeditiously.

In view of the above, without adverting to the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.1 Principal Secretary, Department of Home Affairs and Justice, Punjab, Punjab Civil Secretariat, Chandigarh within six weeks from the receipt of the certified copy of the judgment. In case, on consideration, the competent authority reaches to the conclusion that the benefit claimed by the petitioner is admissible to her, in such eventuality, the consequential relief be allowed to her, within a period of six weeks thereafter. However, in case the competent authority feels that the relief claimed by the petitioner is not admissible or made out, in that case, a speaking order be passed in the matter.
