Husband-petitioner is in the revision petition against the order passed by the learned trial Court fixing the maintenance pendente lite at the rate of ₹15,000/- per month.

It has been found that the petitioner-husband is having a regular income of ₹50,000/- per month. It has been noticed by the Court that the petitioner-husband, in the petition filed under Sections 7, 8 and 17 of the Guardians and Wards Act, had asserted that he is getting a rental income of ₹45,000/- per month. He had further asserted that he had inherited moveable and immovable property from his parents and has sufficient bank balance.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, the learned trial Court has correctly fixed maintenance pendente lite at ₹15,000/- per month.

It is not in dispute that initially wife was serving in Aviation Company i.e. Spice Jet but on the complaint of the husband, she lost her job and since then, she is unemployed.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, there is no ground to interfere.

Revision petition is dismissed.
