Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in case FIR No.350 dated 26.11.2017 under Section 61 of the Punjab Excise Act, 1014, registered at Police Station Kotwali Kapurthala, District Kapurthala.

On 22.11.2019, the following order was passed :-

“Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that as per the allegations in the FIR, registered on the basis of a secret information, a raid was conducted, however, the petitioners ran away from the spot.

Learned counsel for the petitions further submits that the recovery was effected in the absence of the petitioners and nothing is to be recovered from the petitioners. It is further submitted that the petitioners are ready to join the investigation.

Notice of motion for 9.12.2019.”

Learned State counsel submits that the petitioners have already appeared before the Investigating Officer on 4.12.2029.

In view of the same, the present petition is allowed the order dated 22.11.2019 passed by this Court is made absolute, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
