Petitioner-Gupreet Singh @ Gopi has prayed for grant of pre-arrest bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C in case FIR No.79 dated 30.09.2019 registered under Sections 307, 341, 323, 506, 427, 120-B and 148 read with Section 149 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 at Police Station Rawalpindi, District Kapurthala.

The FIR was registered on the statement of Parminder Singh @ Dulla son of Mohan Lal wherein it was alleged that on 30.09.2019, complainant alongwith Akashdeep was going on motorcycle from Phagwara to Rihana Jattan. At about 6.30 p.m. whey they reached near Radha Swami Satsang Ghar, one car came from behind and stopped them. In the meantime, Harpreet Singh @ Happo armed with khanda, Rajan armed with khanda, Gopi armed with khanda (petitioner) along with his accomplices came out

and Harpreet Singh gave khanda blow on the head of the complainant. They all gave injuries to the complainant with their respective weapons and damaged his motorcycle. On raising alarm, all the assailants ran away from the spot. On these broad allegations, FIR was registered.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner was though named in the FIR but was not attributed any injury which invited the offence punishable under Section 307 IPC.

Learned State counsel who is assisted by SI Baldev while opposing the prayer apprised the Court that in all 21 injuries were inflicted upon the victim and the petitioner was armed with khanda and has caused injuries.

Considering the fact that the petitioner is specifically named in the FIR, who was armed with khanda, this Court does not find any reason to extend the extra ordinary concession of pre-arrest bail to the petitioner.

Petition is dismissed.
