Petitioner herein seeks issuance of writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to appoint the petitioner, being son of late Hardev Singh who was working as Chowkidar and died in harness on 04.05.2018, on compassionate grounds.

2. In the premise, petitioner caused a representation dated 22.07.2019 (Annexure.P-4), but the same was not adverted by the respondents. Hence, the writ petition.
