The present petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.510 dated 28.07.2018 (Annexure P-1) under Sections 419, 420, 380, 201, 120- B IPC and Sections 66C & 66 D of IT Act (added later on), registered at Police Station Surajkund, District Faridabad.

Heard.

Allegations against the petitioners in this case are that they used to commit ATM cards fraud. As per the record, they used to make calls to the customers for upgrading their sim cards from 3G to 4G network, get the account details and thereafter, prepare fake ATM cards with swapping machines and then transfer the money from the account of the customers to their account.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the petitioners have effected compromise with the present complainant. However, in this case, six ATM cards were recovered.

Learned State counsel states that the police is still investigating the matter and two accused are yet to be arrested.

Considering the nature of the fraud, there is no ground to grant regular bail the the petitioner.

Accordingly, the present petition is dismissed.
