The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 314 dated 15.10.2019, under Section 174-A of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Gohana, District Sonapat.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is an accused in the proceedings under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instruments Act, 1881. He also contends that the petitioner was not served at the address where he was residing and he is ready to join the proceedings.

This Court, by the order dated 25.11.2019, had directed the petitioner to appear before the Investigating Officer and join the investigation and in the event of his arrest, he was to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from HC Sunil Kumar, states that petitioner has joined investigation and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the submissions of the learned counsel for the petitioner and the petitioner having joined investigation, the order dated 25.11.2019 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. He shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
