The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.125, dated 09.09.2019, under Sections 452, 324, 323, 148, 149 IPC (Section 326 IPC added later on), registered at Police Station Khuian Sarwar, District Fazilka.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that it is a case of version and cross-version in which both the sides have received injuries.

Heard.

It is apparent from the reading of the FIR that the petitioner has caused an injury with a *kirpan* on the forehead of the complainant which was found to be grievous in nature. It might be a case of version and cross-version but the petitioner himself has not received any injury in the incident. Therefore, in view of the petitioner having caused a *kirpan* blow on the head of the complainant, I do not deem it a fit case to grant the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner and the same stands dismissed.
