This petition for habeas corpus has been filed with allegations that 9 persons, mentioned in paragraph 6 of petition, have been illegally detained by respondents No. 4 and 5 who are running a brick kiln and they have not been paid wages since September, 2019.

Status report by way of affidavit of Shri Ashok Kumar Sharma, IAS, District Magistrate cum Deputy Commissioner, Ambala, has been filed in Court today and same is taken on record, wherein it is stated that on receipt of orders of this Court, a Sub Divisional Level Vigilance Committee was constituted to inquire into the allegations. The committee recorded the statements of various persons including the co workers of alleged detainee, who stated that they had come to brick kiln about 20 days back and on 22.11.2019, they alongwith their families and luggage had left to their native village.

In view of aforesaid, petition is disposed of as infructuous.
