Petitioner Virender Kumar Singh has filed this petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.252 dated 09.07.2016, registered at Police Station Dharuhera, District Rewari, under Sections 420, 406, 506 and 34 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860.

Notice of motion has been issued.

Learned State counsel and counsel for the complainant have appeared and contested the instant petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties as well as learned State counsel and gone through the record.

As per the allegation in the FIR, payment of ₹50 lakhs was made by complainant Ishwar Singh through cheque in favour of 'Poonam Multi Specialty Hospital Pvt. Ltd' in which the present petitioner was the

Director. It is further alleged that the accused have cheated the complainant.

They have induced him (complainant) to deposit the said money by saying that they will return the double of the said money after six months.

Challan has already been presented. The petitioner has been in custody since 05.06.2018. He is not required for any investigation or interrogation purposes as he is in judicial custody. The offences are triable by the Judicial Magistrate, 1st Class. The trial of the case may take long time. No useful purpose will be served by keeping him in custody till the final disposal of the case.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts in minute detail and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this criminal miscellaneous petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail subject to his furnishing personal bonds in the sum of ₹50,000/- with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
