Petitioners have approached this Court by assailing the election of Chairman and Vice Chairman of the Bhogpur Cooperative Sugar Mills Ltd., Bhogpur, District Jalandhar-respondent No.7 held on 22.08.2019.

There are allegations made against the Minister, Cooperation and Jail-respondent No.8, which are nothing but bald assertion of the petitioners and are without any substance. Petitioners have admitted in the instant writ petition that there is a statutory remedy of election petition available to them. In the absence of any substantiated allegation of malafide or political interference of respondent No.8, this Court cannot exercise its extra ordinary powers under Article 226 of the Constitution of India.

The petitioners, if so advised, may avail of their statutory remedy of election petition in accordance with law.

With the above observations, the writ petition stands disposed of.
