Petitioner prays for grant of regular bail pending trial in a criminal case arising out from FIR No.582, dated 15.07.2019, registered under Sections 379-A/34 IPC, at Police Station, Nuh, District Nuh.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is not named in the FIR and he sought to be falsely nominated as an accused on the statement of a co-accused.

Mr. Sajid, Advocate, appears for the first informant-victim does not oppose the prayer for bail.

On conclusion of the investigation, police report has been submitted and even charges have been framed.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from SI Ranvir Singh, has submitted that the petitioner is not involved in any other criminal case.

Without commenting on the merits of the case and keeping in view the fact that the petitioner is in custody since 17.07.2019 and the hearing of the case is likely to take long time, the petitioner is directed to be released on regular bail subject to furnishing of adequate surety to the

satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.

Accordingly the petition is allowed with the aforesaid directions.
