ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.191 dated 29.09.2019, under Section 306 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station City Malout, District Sri Muktsar Sahib.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the allegations in the FIR are that the petitioner and two other co-accused owed Rs.15,00,000/- to the deceased due to which he committed suicide. He also contends that the deceased had been admitted in Guru Gobind Singh Medical College, Faridkot and he had left the hospital against doctor's advice and thereafter he had committed suicide.

This Court, by the order dated 26.11.2019, had directed the petitioner to appear before the Investigating Officer and join the investigation and in the event of his arrest, he was to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Karnail Singh, states that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the submissions of the learned counsel for the petitioner and the petitioner having joined investigation, the order dated 26.11.2019 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. He shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
