ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.1097 dated 01.10.2019, under Sections 148, 149, 427, 506, 455 & 120-B IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act, 1959, registered at Police Station City Thanesar, District Kurukshetra.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the allegations against the petitioner are that the petitioner along with co-accused had caused heavy damage to the hotel of the complainant. He further contends that no one was injured in the occurrence. He also contends that the co-accused Sanjiv Kumar had been granted bail by this Court in CRM-M-49007-2019 on 26.11.2019. The petitioner is 21 years of age and he is in custody for about 2 months.

Learned State counsel contends that the petitioner is also involved in other similar cases as well. He further states that although

challan has been filed but the charges are yet to be framed. He also submits that heavy damage was caused to the hotel of the complainant.

Heard.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner, especially when petitioner is 21 years of age, he is in custody for about 2 months and the conclusion of the trial is likely to take some time, I deem it a fit case to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
