Prayer in this petition is for cancellation of anticipatory bail granted to accused-respondent No.2 in FIR No.41 dated 16.06.2015 under Sections 307, 452, 34 IPC, registered at Police Station Dera Baba Nanak, Gurdaspur, District Gurdaspur, vide order dated 30.07.2016 passed by the Addl. Sessions Judge, Gurdaspur.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from HC Rajbir Singh, has submitted that in the intervening period, out of total 07 prosecution witnesses, 03 PWs have been examined, including the complainant.

A perusal of this petition shows that only reason is given that some misstatement was made regarding contents of the FIR, when the bail was

granted on 30.07.2016, however, none of the grounds, which are available to a complainant-victim for cancellation of bail i.e. extending threat to any of the witness; misuse of concession of bail and involvement of an accused person in any subsequent case, are neither pleaded in the petition nor are part of affidavit filed by the petitioner.

In view of the above, I find no ground for cancellation of anticipatory bail granted to accused-respondent No.2

Accordingly, the present petition is dismissed.
