In a suit for permanent injunction and mandatory injunction, the plaintiff had filed an application for appointment of Local Commissioner. Such application has been dismissed by the trial Court of Civil Judge (Jr.Divn.), Samana vide a detailed and well reasoned order. The plaintiff is aggrieved by the said order, which has been challenged in this revision petition.

The plaintiff can lead evidence with regard to the points for which Local Commissioner is desired to be got appointed. The Court is not to collect the evidence for the plaintiff by way of appointment of a

Local Commissioner. The order does not suffer from any illegality or infirmity, which might have called for interference by way of accepting the revision petition.

Finding no merit in the civil revision petition, the same stands dismissed.
