Prayer in this petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in FIR No.115 dated 31.03.2018 under Sections 346, 363, 366-A IPC, Section 4 of the POCSO Act, 2012 and

Atrocities) Act, 1989 (Amendment 2015) (the offences punishable under Sections 363, 366-A and Section 4 of the POCSO Act were deleted and Section 3(2-B) of the SC&ST Act and Sections 6 & 18 of the POCSO Act were added later on), registered at Police Station Sadar Fatehabad, District Fatehabad.

Learned State Counsel, on instructions from ASI Hardayal, has informed this Court that trial in the case is at advanced stage as against total 26 witnesses cited by the prosecution, as many as 17 witnesses have been examined, whereas one witness has been given up.

In view of the advanced stage of trial, learned counsel for the petitioner does not press the present petition at this stage.

Dismissed as not pressed.

However, considering the fact that the petitioner is in custody since 01.04.2018 and the complainant has been declared hostile in the case, the trial Court shall make an endeavour to expedite the trial.
