filed seeking protection of life and liberty, the contents thereof be duly
verified and if necessary, requisite steps be taken strictly in
accordance with law for grant of protection of life and liberty to the
petitioners. It is clarified that this order shall not be treated as a stamp
of approval or validity by this Court as to marriage of the parties, if
any.

It is also made clear that this order shall have no import in
the event any challenge is made as to the validity of the marriage.
