Petitioner prays for grant of regular bail in FIR No.76 dated 01.04.2019 registered under Section 379 of IPC and Sections 411, 467, 468, 471, 473, 420 of IPC (added later on) at Police Station Kotwali Patiala, District Patiala.

This is second bail application filed by the petitioner. First one was dismissed on 05.07.2019.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Suba Singh, has submitted that as many as 55 stolen vehicles have been recovered from the petitioner and he is habitual offender, involved in many criminal cases of similar nature.

In view thereof, this Court is not inclined to grant regular bail to the petitioner.

Accordingly, the present petition is dismissed.
