The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 94 dated 25.08.2019, under Sections 380 and 454 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Dhariwal, District Gurdaspur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that it is alleged that when the complainant returned to her house, she found that the almirah was broken and an amount of ₹5,000/- was found missing from her purse. He also contends that the petitioner is not named in the FIR and has been arraigned as an accused on mere suspicion. He also contends that the petitioner was 17 years and 7 months of age at the time of occurrence and he is not involved in any other case.

This Court, by the order dated 25.11.2019, had directed the petitioner to appear before the investigating/arresting officer and join the investigation and in the event of his arrest, he was to be released on ad interim bail subject to the satisfaction of the investigating/arresting officer.

Learned State counsel on instructions from SI Jagjit Singh,

states that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required

for custodial interrogation.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner and the petitioner having joined investigation, the order dated 25.11.2019 granting ad interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. He shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
