Learned counsel for the petitioners state that the similarly situated persons have been allowed to change the option in view of the order passed by this Court in CWP-2407-2013, titled as **Partap Singh and others vs. State of Haryana and others**, decided on 05.02.2015 (Annexure P9).

Learned counsel further contends that the petitioners are similarly situated as the petitioners in the abovementioned writ petition, hence, they are entitled for the same benefit.

Counsel for the petitioners state that for the relief which has been claimed in the present writ petition, the petitioners have served the respondents with a legal notice dated 17.07.2017 (Annexure P10) and the petitioners will be satisfied, at this stage, in case a time bound direction is issued to the respondents to decide the legal notice dated 17.07.2017 (Annexure P10) by passing a speaking order.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case or about the entitlement of the petitioners for the relief which has been claimed by them in the legal notice dated 17.07.2017 (Annexure P10), the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to decide the aforesaid legal notice within a period of three months from the receipt of certified copy of this order.

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In case, it is found that the petitioners are entitled to any monetary benefits after the decision of the legal notice, the same should also be paid to the petitioners within three months thereafter.
