In the instant petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C., prayer has been made for issuance of directions to respondents No. 1 and 2 to entrust the investigation of FIR No. 84 dated 17.05.2018 under Sections 457 and 380 IPC, Police Station Baghapurana, District Moga (Annexure P-1) to some Senior Police Officer or some other independent agency like Central Bureau of Investigation, for fair investigation and to look into false implication of the petitioner in the present case, as the police is not taking any action, despite the submission of representation dated 03.07.2018 (Annexure P-7) sent to respondent No.2 DGP, Punjab through registered post and earlier representation dated 25.05.2018 (Annexure P-6) sent to Additional DGP (Law and Order) NRI Affairs Punjab.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the purpose of instant petition would be achieved, if, respondent

No.3-Senior Superintendent of Police, Moga is directed to decide representated Annexures P-6 and P-7 moved by the petitioner.

In view of above, the petitioner is directed to furnish copy of representation Annexure P-6 and P-7 addressed to Add. DGP (Law and Order) NRI Affairs Punjab, Phase 7, Mohali and DGP, Punjab, Sector 9, Chandigarh within a week from today before respondent No. 3-Senior Superintendent of Police, District Moga, who in turn would look into the matter and decide the representation Annexures P-6 and P-7, moved by the petitioner, in accordance with law, by passing a speaking order and after affording an opportunity of hearing to the authorized person of the petitioner, within a period of two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

The instant petition stands disposed of, accordingly.
