This is second application for bail pending trial filed by the petitioner in FIR No.17 dated 30.01.2019 registered under Section 22 of Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 and under Section 473 IPC (added later on) at Police Station, City Moga, District Moga.

As per the case of the prosecution, the petitioner was found in conscious possession of 3990 tablets of Tramadol (intoxicant tablets). The first bail petition was withdrawn on 19.08.2019.

Keeping in view the facts of the case, this Court is not inclined to grant concession of bail to the petitioner. However, the learned trial court is requested to make sincere endeavour to expeditiously dispose of the case.
