Present petition has been filed challenging the order dated 18.09.2019 passed by the learned Principal Judge, Family Court, Ludhiana by which application filed by one Akhtiar Singh aged about 68 years against his son namely, Inderdeep Singh by which the interim maintenance of Rs.3,000/- per month has been granted.

Son namely, Inderdeep Singh has preferred the present petition challenging the same on the ground that the father owes a lot of property having brick kiln also and is a rich person.

After giving a thoughtful consideration to the present petition and considering the provisions of Section 125(2) Cr.P.C, grant of interim maintenance of Rs.3,000/- by the learned Illaqa Magistrate during the pendency of the application under Section 125 Cr.P.C seems to be wholly justified particularly when there is a statutory provision in this regard and the respondent is approximately 68 years of age. The contention raised by learned counsel for the petitioner that his father holds a lot of property and a

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rich person would not hold good while grant of interim maintenance as it would otherwise defeat the very object of statutory provisions as contained in Section 125(2) Cr.P.C. Accordingly, the present petition is hereby dismissed.
