Mother of petitioner filed CRM-M-27238 of 2018 seeking directions to the respondents for taking necessary action against respondents No. 5 to 7 (in the criminal petition) on the ground that they had forcibly entered into the land belonging to the complainant and had damaged the standing crops and torn her clothes.

The petition was disposed of on 4.7.2018 directing the Senior Superintendent of Police (Rural), District Amritsar, to look into the matter and decide the representation expeditiously preferable within a period of two months.

The present contempt petition has been filed pleading that needful is not done.

Learned state counsel on instructions from SI Dhanvinder Singh submits that the representation was looked into and allegations were found to be false. He further submits that the order/inquiry report would be communicated to the counsel for the petitioner within one week from today.

In view of above, the contempt petition is disposed of.

However, the petitioner shall be at liberty to avail remedy in accordance with law against the said order.
