Learned counsel states that the petitioners have been serving on part-time basis as Sweeper, Cook, Water Carrier with effect from the year 2009 onwards and on 28.7.2014, details of petitioner Nos.1, 3 and 4 were sought from the concerned SHOs for considering their case for regularization but no decision was taken in respect thereto instead with effect from 1.4.2019, the petitioners are not being allowed to perform duty despite representation Annexure P-5 (undated).

2. After arguing for some time, learned counsel prays for permission to withdraw the writ petition with liberty to file a comprehensive representation and directions being issued to respondent No.3 to consider and decide the representation on receipt in a time bound manner.

2. Notice of motion.

3. Mr. Harish Rathee, Sr. DAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and states that he has no objection to the innocuous prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioners.

4. Without commenting upon the merits of the case or the entitlement of the petitioners qua the relief claimed, the writ petition is permitted to be withdrawn with liberty to submit a comprehensive representation within two weeks from today. In case any representation is submitted by the petitioners to respondent No.3 within two weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order, the same be considered and decided in accordance with law within two months thereafter.
