ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.133 dated 16.10.2019, under Sections 306 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Majitha Road, District Police Commissionerate, Amritsar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the allegations in the FIR are that the husband of the petitioner had entered into an agreement to sell with the deceased. He also contends that the deceased is alleged to have committed suicide because of financial difficulties and the aforementioned agreement to sell entered into between him and the husband of the petitioner. He also contends that the petitioner has been falsely implicated, as she is the wife of co-accused, namely, Gurwinder Singh.

This Court, by the order dated 27.11.2019, had directed the petitioner to appear before the Investigating Officer and join the investigation and in the event of her arrest, she was to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Parminder Singh, states that the petitioner has joined investigation and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the submissions of the learned counsel for the petitioner and the petitioner having joined investigation, the order dated 27.11.2019 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. She shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
