The present petition has been filed by the petitioner under Section 439 Cr.P.C for grant of bail pending trial in case FIR No.492 dated 09.09.2017 registered under Sections 307, 325 & 34 IPC and 25 of Arms Act, 1959, at Police Station Ganaur, District Sonipat.

It is pointed out by the counsel for the State, on instructions from SI Mukesh Kumar, that out of total 37 witnesses, 24 have already been examined and today is the date fixed before the trial court. Some of the witnesses have been summoned even for today. In any case, the prosecution is leading its evidence in the right earnest. It is further pointed out that there are 10 more cases against the petitioner, including the cases under Sections 307 and 302 IPC.

In view of the above, at this stage this court is not inclined to grant bail to the petitioner.
