Petitioners allege harassment at the hands of the police officials arrayed as party respondents by name i.e. respondents No.4 and 5.

Counsel submits that without even registration of the FIR, the premises of the petitioners are being raided repeatedly and respondents No.4 and 5 are acting without any authority in law.

Without even ascertaining the correctness of the averments made in the petition as also the submissions advanced by counsel, I deem it appropriate to dispose of the instant writ petition in terms of granting liberty to the petitioners to approach the Superintendent of Police, Bathinda as regards their grievance. In the eventuality of any application/representation being preferred, respondent No.3 would be obligated to look into the matter and to thereafter take steps as he may deem fit and warranted in accordance with law.
