1. Learned counsel contends that the petitioner served as Extension Lecturer in Chemistry in Govt. College Narnaud w.e.f. 21.08.2015 to 10.11.2015 and 07.01.2016 to 12.04.2016 as is evident from certificate Annexure P/1 issued by the Principal Govt. College, Narnaud, Hisar. Thereafter, the petitioner worked as Extension Lecturer in the subject of Chemistry from 20.07.2016 to 16.11.2016, 02.01.2017 to 15.04.2017, 11.08.2017 to 11.11.2017, 01.01.2018 to 11.08.2018 and lastly from 07.09.2018 to 18.09.2019 as is evident from the certificate issued by the Principle of Govt. College, Narnaud, Hisar Annexure P/1 (colly) dated 19.09.2019. Learned counsel contends that as per the work allotted for the session 2019-20, as contained in Annexure P/3, as against the requirement of three Lecturers in the subject of Chemistry, only two Extension Lecturers were posted, therefore, there was shortage of one Extension Lecturer for teaching the subject of Chemistry in Govt. College, Barwala, Hisar.

Learned counsel contends that the petitioner has submitted representation Annexure P/4 dated 18.09.2014 to various colleges in the State of Haryana followed by legal notice Annexure P/8 dated 30.09.2019 to respondent Nos.2 and 3, but the same has not been decided till date and the petitioner would be satisfied if the writ petition is disposed of at this stage by directing respondent No.3 to consider and decide the claim as made in legal notice Annexure P/8 dated 30.09.2019, in accordance with law, in a time bound manner.

2. Notice of motion. Mr. Harish Rathee, Sr. DAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and states that he has no objection to the limited prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner.

3. In view of the position as noted above and without commenting on the merits of the claim or for that matter the entitlement of the petitioner to be appointed as Extension Lecturer in Govt. College, Barwala, Hisar or elsewhere, the writ petition is disposed of by directing respondent No.3 to consider and decide the claim made in the legal notice Annexure P/8 dated 30.09.2019, within four weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
