Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.PC is for issuance of a direction to the official respondents No.2 and 3 so as to stop harassing the petitioner and her relatives on the asking of the private respondents.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the respondents No.2 and 3 are harassing the petitioner and her relatives at the instance of respondent No.6 with whom the marriage of petitioner was solemnised on 14.01.2014. Respondent No.6 is a drug-addict, alcoholic and used to give beatings to the petitioner due to which she had to leave her matrimonial home on 12.06.2019.

The present petition has been filed by the petitioner without making any representation to the authorities concerned for redressal of her grievances. Therefore, the present petition is disposed of at this stage with a

direction that in case the petitioner submits such like representation detailing her grievances to the respondent No.4 i.e. SHO, Police Station Noormahal, District Jalandhar within a week from today, the same shall be considered in accordance with law.
