AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASIH, J. (ORAL)

Petitioner has approached this Court praying for issuance of writ of mandamus directing respondents No.2 and 3 to sanction mutation with regard to the property in the revenue record on the basis of registered Will dated 12.08.2002 (Annexure P-2) left by Mahant Shri Pargat Puri, who died on 01.04.2019 or further directing respondents to consider and decide the representation dated 12.06.2019 (Annexure P-3) seeking property mutation within some specified time.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the Will which has been produced by the petitioner in her favour has not been challenged by anyone.

3. Perusal of the pleadings as well as the order dated 03.05.2019 (Annexure P-4) passed by the Civil Judge (Junior Division), Mukerian, it is apparent that there is a civil litigation pending between the parties and that apart, the competent authority shall take a decision as and when the situation arises for taking such a decision.

4. No ground for issuance of a mandamus, as prayed for, at this stage, is made out.

5. The writ petition stands dismissed.
