HARINDER SINGH SIDHU, J.

The petitioners have filed this petition under Section 438 read with 482 of Cr.P.C. for grant of pre-arrest bail in case FIR No.266 dated 30.08.2019 under Sections 326, 324, 323, 506, 148, 149 Indian Penal Code, 1860 (Section 3 (1) SC/ST Act, 1956 added later on), Police Station Sadar Tarn Taran, District Tarn Taran.

The FIR was lodged on the complaint of one Tarsem Singh. He stated that on 21.08.2019 his son, who was coming back from the house of his uncle, on the way Gurbinderjit Singh Fauji taunted him for wearing sunglasses. Arguments ensued between them. A complaint was made against Gurbinderjit Singh Fauji at Police Post Khadur Sahib as also to the office of SSP, Tarn Taran. After making the complaint, when the complainant and his son were returning, Paramjit Singh, Gurbinderjit Singh, Amritpal Singh, Sukhwinder Singh all armed with *datars*, Nirvail Singh armed with hockey and Dilbag Singh @ Lati empty handed came on three

motorcycles from the side of Tarn Taran and stopped their motorcycles in front of the complainant's motorcycle. Dilbag Singh raised *lalkara* to catch hold of them and teach them a lesson for arguing with Gurbinderjit Singh and for making a police complaint. Paramjit Singh – petitioner No.1 inflicted a *datar* blow on the knee of the right leg of the complainant. Sukhwinder Singh @ Soni inflicted a *datar* blow on his wrist of left hand. When Karaj Singh, son of the complainant came forward to save him, then Amritpal Singh – petitioner No.2 gave a blow of *datar* which hit on the left leg of Karaj Singh. Gurbinderjit Singh Fauji gave a *datar* blow, which hit the wrist of right hand of Karaj Singh.

As per the medico legal report, the injuries caused on the person of the son of the complainant were declared grievous in nature and stated to have been caused by a sharp-edged weapon.

No ground is made out to grant benefit of pre-arrest bail to the petitioners.

Dismissed.
