Prayer in the writ petition is for the issuance of a writ of Mandamus for directing the respondents to release the sanctioned and assured capital subsidy/investment incentive of Rs.18,51,500/- sanctioned vide letter Annexure P-2 dated 27.09.2001 alongwith interest @ 6% per annum with effect from the date of entitlement till realization in view of order dated 20.05.2011 passed by this Court in CWP No.19007 of 2002 in case titled as M/s Balak Gases Oxygen Gas Plant Ltd. Vs. State of Punjab and others.

2. Learned counsel states that the petitioner has submitted representation Annexure P-3 dated 10.09.2019 but the same has not been decided till date and in the circumstances, the petitioner would be satisfied, if the writ petition is disposed of, at this stage, by directing respondent No.2 to consider and decide the representation Annexure P-3 dated 10.09.2019 in accordance with law in a time bound manner.

3. Notice of motion.

4. Ms. Kanica Sachdeva, AAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and states that she has no objection to the limited prayer of the petitioner.

5. Without commenting on the merits of the case or the entitlement of the petitioner to the relief claimed, the writ petition is disposed of by directing respondent No.2 to consider and decide the representation Annexure P-3 dated 10.09.2019 in accordance with law as expeditiously as possible within three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
