On 27.11.2019, following order was passed:-

“Petitioner prays for grant of pre-arrest bail in a criminal case arising out from FIR No. 228 dated 17.08.2019, registered under Sections 406/420/120-B IPC, at Police Station City Kapurthala, District Kapurthala.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is only an employee of M/s HIM Agro Food Corporation and is sought to be falsely implicated. He also relies upon an order dated 15.11.2019, passed in CRM-M-48378-2019 and CRM-M-48457-2019.

Notice of motion for 09.12.2019.

On asking of the Court, Mr.SPS Tinna, Addl.A.G.,Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the State. A copy of the petition be handed over to Mr.SPS Tinna, Addl.A.G.,Punjab, during the course of the day.

In the meantime, in the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on interim bail subject to furnishing personal bonds and surety to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

To be heard with CRM-M-48378-2019 & CRM-M-48457-2019.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Varinder, has

submitted that the petitioner has joined the investigation, cooperated and is not required for further custodial interrogation.

In view thereof, interim order dated 27.11.2019 passed by this Court is made absolute.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed.
